Title: REPHASING OF JOINT HQ WORK

Executive Summary: To be completed by PCC Specialist lead

This report asks for a decision to extend the overall project construction period for the new Force HQ to facilitate use of the current firing range until completion of the training centre and the new firing range project.

The proposal does not impact on the build timescale for the new HQ but on the associated landscaping and car parking works that follow on from the construction of the new Joint Headquarters.

The existing firearms range underneath the Executive Block at the HQ site and this building was originally intended for partial demolition whilst maintaining structural integrity of the basement and enveloping this with a new roof structure which would serve as car parking above.

The accreditation issue now renders this option as economically unviable and would ultimately leave a legacy structure with limited use and with long term maintenance and running costs.

Consultation has taken place with the Derbyshire Fire and Rescue Authority who are supportive proposals to amend the timing of the delivery of the joint HQ at Ripley, to accommodate the continued use of the existing firing range,

The attached confidential report outlines the full financial implications of the preferred option to split the construction contract.

Decision

Resolved that the Commissioner approves the contract timing amendment and the associated budget amendments to the joint Fire and Police HQ new build as detailed in the confidential report, under option 2.
