Executive Summary:

To seek approval for the award of a contract under framework RM3733 Technology Products 2 for the (Lot 3) Provision of Firewall Software and Support Comprising Checkpoint Infrastructure Support, Software Licences and Support and Cisco Infrastructure Support, Software Licences and Support to be provided by Insight Direct UK Ltd for the period of contract or extension 1 February 2017 to 31 January 2020 for the total contract value of £227,125.14, with an option to extend for a further one year, as detailed in the attached report.

**RECOMMENDATION FOR THE AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY OF
FIREWALLS SOFTWARE**

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 To seek approval for the award of a contract under framework RM3733 Technology Products 2 for the (Lot 3) Provision of Firewall Software and Support Comprising Checkpoint Infrastructure Support, Software Licences and Support and Cisco Infrastructure Support, Software Licences and Support to be provided by Insight Direct UK Ltd for the period of contract or extension 1 February 2017 to 31 January 2020 for the total contract value of £227,125.14, with an option to extend for a further one year.

INFORMATION AND ANALYSIS

- 2.1 The Commissioner currently has had agreements for the support of Checkpoint Firewall Infrastructure and Software, the lot 1 requirement, and Cisco Firewall Infrastructure and Software, the lot 2 requirement but both expired in December 2016.
- 2.2 An agreement is currently in place for first line Checkpoint support with Cygnia Technologies, Birmingham B69 2DG. This agreement will remain.
- 2.3 2 suppliers submitted bids: Insight Direct UK Ltd and Computacenter UK Ltd.
- 2.4 Based on the detailed evaluation of the responses to the quality questions, Computacenter UK scored the highest marks. Computacenter UK provided a detailed method statement describing how they propose to implement and deliver the contract, including a detailed implementation plan and how they will communicate with the Constabulary. The response was evidenced with detail of their accreditation for supplying Checkpoint / Cisco support.
- 2.5 Based on the detailed price evaluation, the costs were scored in relation to the separate lots – Lot 1, Lot 2 and Lot 3. Insight Direct UK scored the highest marks for Lot 1 (Checkpoint), Insight Direct UK scored the highest marks for Lot 2 (Cisco) and Insight Direct UK scored the high marks for Lot 3 (Checkpoint and Cisco).
- 2.6 As the scoring was 80% based on price, the contract will be awarded under Lot 3. By choosing to award the contract under Lot 3, the best value option has been sourced. There is a total of £69,740.01 difference between the two suppliers. If the contract was awarded under two separate lots – Lot 1 and Lot 2, based upon the overall score (price and quality) then Computacenter UK Ltd would be awarded the Lot 2 (Cisco) contract. By opting to award the contract under Lot 3, a saving of £1,504.16 is made.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- i. Recommend approval for the award of contract under Framework RM3733 Technology Products 2 for the (Lot 1) Provision of Firewall Software and Support Comprising Checkpoint Infrastructure Support, Software Licences and Support and Cisco Infrastructure Support, Software Licences and Support to be provided by Insight Direct UK Ltd for the period of contract or extension 1 February 2017 to 31 January 2020 for the total contract value of £227,125.14, with an option to extend for a further one year.
