**RECOMMENDATION TO AWARD THE CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY OF
DATACENTRE NETWORK SWITCHING EQUIPMENT**

1 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 Recommend approval, subject to representations received during the voluntary standstill period, for the award of contract under Crown Commercial Service Agreement RM1058, Technology Services, Lot 5 for the supply of Datacentre Network Switching Equipment to be provided by Dimension Data Network Services Limited for the period of 27 February 2017 to 26 February 2019 with an option to extend for a further 3 years in annual increments. The contract value for the initial period is £311,707.77.

2 INFORMATION AND ANALYSIS

2.1 Warranty and support for the Alcatel brand devices ceases in April 2017, with all units becoming 'end of life'. Both the manufacturer and the Technical Support Provider have advised that it cannot be extended; therefore the Authority has to replace this equipment.

2.2 This Further Competition has been conducted under the Crown Commercial Services Technology Services Framework agreement (RM1058) . The evaluation team consisted of Sunny Atwal (Project Manager), Christopher Maric and Craig Barber (Network Analysts) and Kirsty Holding (Procurement Assistant) for Derbyshire Constabulary. 55 suppliers were identified under the framework and were invited to tender. 4 suppliers submitted bids.

2.3 Most Economical Advantageous Tender Criteria (MEAT): Weighting 30% Price and 70% Quality. Based on the detailed evaluation of the responses to the quality questions, Dimension Data Network Services Limited scored the highest marks. Dimension Data Network Services Limited provided a detailed response to the method statements, including a comprehensive implementation plan specifying how they will deliver and install the hardware and software by end of April 2017.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Recommend approval, subject to representations during the voluntary standstill period, for the award of contract under Crown Commercial Service Agreement RM1058, Technology Services, Lot 5 for the supply of Datacentre Network Switching Equipment to be provided by Dimension Data Network Services Limited for the period of 27 February 2017 to 26 February 2019 with an option to extend for a further 3 years in annual increments. The contract value for the initial period is £311,707.77.
