1 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 1.1 Recommend approval to award contract for The Provision of Services for the Disposal & Re-Cycling of End of Life Vehicles (Non-Police) to be provided by RAW2K Ltd for the period of 11th September 2017 to 10th September 2021. Annual income estimated from this contract is £75,000 per annum.

2 INFORMATION AND ANALYSIS

- 2.1 Derbyshire Constabulary must obtain the best available financial return on vehicles with the least possible overheads while maintaining an ethical and lawful operation in every respect. Vehicles may be scrapped, dismantled or sold as assessed by the contractor.
- 2.2 End of life vehicles are to be disposed of through licensed Authorised Treatment Facilities (ATF) in accordance with End of Life Vehicle (ELV) Regulations, as per European Regulations Directive 2000/53/EC dated 18th September 2000 (End of Life Regulations). Scrap Metal Dealers Act 2013 and Scrap Metal Dealers Act 2013 (Commencement and Transitional Provisions) Order 2013 (SI 2013/ 1966) – it is a requirement of the contract that every Motor Salvage Operator (as defined in the Act) being used for the scrapping or dismantling of vehicles will be registered and licensed by the local authority within whose areas they have their site.
- 2.3 Leicestershire Police conducted an open OJEU tender process for the delivery of these services and Derbyshire Constabulary was named as a potential user of the resulting contract.
The contract allows for a direct award of contract to a single provider.
- 2.4 As the contract put in place by Leicestershire Police is a regional collaboration with a single provider, the maximum level of returns and service were able to be negotiated with the supplier.
Original bids were assessed against the quality criteria set out in the Invitation to Tender document – Most Economical Advantageous Tender Criteria (MEAT).
RAW2K Ltd's bid was the highest scoring response on both elements of the criteria.
