The Chronicle Firearms software was installed onto the Derbyshire IS Network in June 2013 following a regional procurement. This contract has now expired and forces are now responsible for the procurement of on-going support and maintenance.

A compliant route to procure has been identified utilising the Police ICT Company Specialist Police Competencies and Assets Framework, which offers a direct award option for existing systems from the Chronicle provider JML Software Solutions Ltd

As this requirement was for the continuation of an existing established system which the force has developed over a number of years, alternatives (which are limited) were not considered as the associated costs were deemed excessive (new software, hardware, training, etc), also the supplier was contacted to ensure that costs would be fixed for the duration of the contract.
