POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER AWARD OF FUNDING TO DERBY
WOMEN'S CENTRE 2015-16

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 1.1 To approve the award of a one-off grant of £10,000 to Derby Women's Centre backed by MOJ funding.

2. INFORMATION AND ANALYSIS

- 2.1 The Commissioner has funding from the Ministry of Justice to provide, or arrange for the provision of, services to help victims cope and recover. This grant is to be awarded under this funding.
- 2.2 The Commissioner has determined to award a Victim Cope and Recover grant to Derby Women's Centre to support victims of domestic abuse. This meets his crime objectives and offers value for money.
- 2.3 The funds will assist in expanding on the work of the pilot project to raise awareness of domestic abuse in the Pakistani community. It is also anticipated to take this work further by working in additional communities in Derby and by tackling alcohol/substance misuse and petty crime, as well as domestic abuse.
- 2.4 There are several benefits for women and families. By continuing to work with perpetrators of domestic abuse to reduce occurrences of incidents so that fewer families will experience this. Working to tackle drug/alcohol misuse and petty crime will also have a positive impact on families.
- 2.5 Grant criteria will be set and regular monitoring reporting will be required from the recipients.

2.7 Section 143 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 provides the Commissioner with powers to award crime and disorder reduction grants. The COMMISSIONER'S GRANT can be used to commission services to help victims or witnesses of, or other persons affected by, offences and antisocial behaviour and to keep people, particularly the most vulnerable in our communities, safe from harm, anti-social behaviour and criminal activities.

2. RECOMMENDATION

- i. To approve the MoJ Cope and Recover Grant of £10,000 as detailed in the report.
