**Title: SALE OF LAND TO DERBYSHIRE FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICE**

**Executive Summary:**

During 2015 the Constabulary has been in negotiations with the Derbyshire Fire and Rescue Service to build a joint firearms range/training centre close to the new Joint Headquarters site. As part of these arrangements negotiations have taken place to dispose of a share of the land to enable the fire service to build their own training facility. The final ownership of the joint facility will fall within the LLP arrangements already put in place for the Joint Police and Fire Headquarters.

A confidential detailed report has been considered by the Commissioner and outlines the negotiations that have taken place.

The report also details the current net cost of the Constabulary elements of the Joint Training Centre, in particular the firearms range and associated costs relating to the redundant helicopter base.

**Decision**

**Resolved that the Commissioner agrees to dispose of land for the joint firearms range and training facility as outlined in paragraph 2.4 of the confidential report and outlined in the site plan attached as an appendix to the report.**
