Title: Golden Nominal Project – Collaboration with East Midlands Forces for the purchase and use of new Records Management System

Executive Summary: To be completed by PCC Specialist lead

In November 2014 the Force committed to replacing its Crime and Intelligence system and its Custody Records Management System with one fully integrated system using 'Golden Nominal Principals' to improve operational effectiveness and reduce costs. The market for such a system is limited and the three main systems available were considered.

Following consideration by the Force's 'Golden Nominal Project Board', the Force's Executive Team and the OPCC, the PCC is being asked for approval to procure the new Records Management System (RMS) to replace the existing Force Crime & Intelligence and Custody Records systems.

The system will offer opportunities for stronger collaborative working within the East Midlands region.

The PCC will be able to use a regional Section 22 collaborative agreement in order to procure the system.

By using this system there will be significant regional interoperability and operational benefits as well as savings on the implementation costs as this will form part of the regional roll out of the system.
