**Title: AMENDMENT TO DECISION NUMBER 31/13 REGARDING THE
ALLOCATION OF COMMISSIONER'S COMMUNITY SAFETY FUNDING 2013/14**

Executive Summary: To be completed by PCC Specialist lead

At the Strategic Governance Board Meeting dated 18 March 2013, it was proposed and agreed that the principle for the allocation of CSF for 2013/14 be in the form of grants to existing partners to support current programmes for community safety, crime reduction and anti-social behaviour. Contained within table 1 of the report was the proposed allocation of the Community Safety Fund to be made to Derby City and Derbyshire County Council.

To avoid unnecessary bureaucracy it is proposed that the County CSF funding be split so that each district receives £23,250 and this be paid direct.

The recommendation below updates decision 31/13 originally agreed at the meeting on 18 March 2013.

Decision

Resolved that

- i. Grant offers from the Police and Crime Commissioner's Community Safety Fund be made to Derby City Council and Derbyshire County Council in accordance with Table 1 of the report, except that to avoid bureaucracy, County CSF funding of £23,250 per district will be paid to them directly.
- ii. A payment schedule be agreed based on a suitable monitoring and reporting programme.
