Title: ADDRESS BASE SOFTWARE

Executive Summary: To be completed by PCC Specialist lead

Approval was sought from the Police and Crime Commissioner to fund the upgrade of address base software and to note the formal amendment to the Capital Programme which will be determined at the Strategic Governance Board in October. Address Point Software programme provides the core GIS address mapping database that feeds a number of key force systems including Command and Control and Intelligence. AddressPoint is due to be withdrawn by the providers at the end of October 2014.

A full business case presenting the options available to the Constabulary was attached to the report as Confidential Appendix A.
