**Title: Police and Crime Commissioner Grant Awards 2015-16**

**Executive Summary: To be completed by PCC Specialist lead**

The report detailed the decision for Round 6 of the Commissioner's Crime Prevention Grant and the Commissioner's award of grant to support victims of crime.

Altogether 65 applications valued at £983,771.31 were submitted, of those 45 were large grant applications and 20 small grant applications.

The Commissioner determined to award 16 CPG grants to the organisations detailed in table 1 of the report.

The Commissioner determined to award 1 Victim Cope and Recover grant to the organisation detailed in Table 2.

The value of the grants to be supported slightly exceeds the 2015-16 budget for Crime Prevention Grants, the balance of £13,856 will be taken from small underspends on various previous grant rounds.
