



COMMISSIONER INVITES APPLICATIONS TO HIS SMALL GRANTS SCHEME

The latest round of the Commissioner's Community Action Small Grants scheme is underway which invites community groups and non-profit organisations to apply for a grant of up to £2,500 to help them achieve their community safety goals.

Community groups have until March 1 to apply for a small grant for projects to be funded over a 12 month period. Further rounds will close on July 1 and November 1 this year. Details can be found [here](#).
