The Police and Crime Commissioner's Group Accounts and the Chief Constable's Accounts are subject to external audit by Mr Andrew Cardoza of KPMG LLP, St Nicholas House, 31 Park Row, Nottingham, NG1 6FQ. Members of the public and local government electors have certain rights in the audit process:

1. From 1st June 2018 to 12th July 2018, between 8:30am to 12:00pm and 2:00pm to 4:00pm Monday to Friday (except on bank holidays) any person may on application inspect the accounts of the Commissioner and Chief Constable for the year ended 31st March 2018 and certain related documents (comprising books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts) at Derbyshire Force Headquarters, Butterley Hall, Ripley, Derbyshire, DE5 3RS. They may also make copies of the accounts and documents.
2. A local government elector (or representative) of Derbyshire may ask the auditor questions about the accounts. Please contact the auditor at the address given above to make arrangements to ask any questions.
3. A local government elector (or representative) of Derbyshire may object to the Commissioners and Chief Constables accounts asking the auditor to issue a report in the public interest and/or apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law. Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to us at the address given below.
