

Quarterly Report - January to March 2019

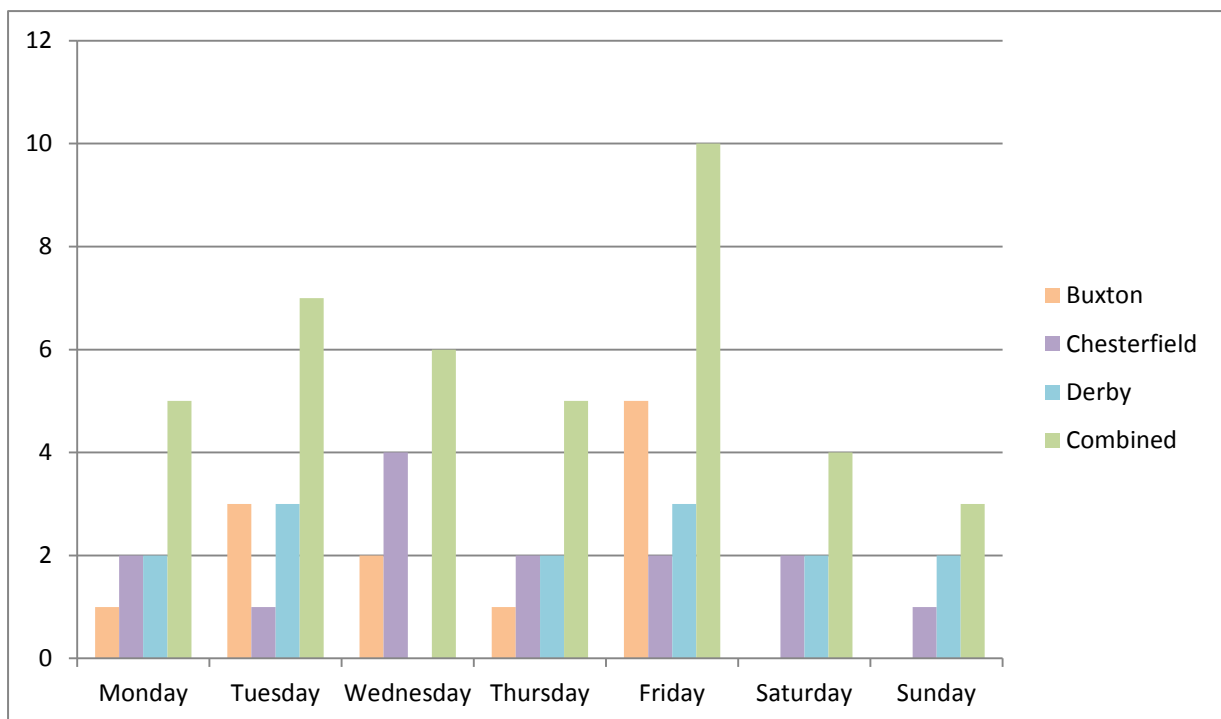
During the above period there were 3432 people held in custody in Derbyshire.

The below tables are statistics gathered from our Independent Custody Visiting Scheme.

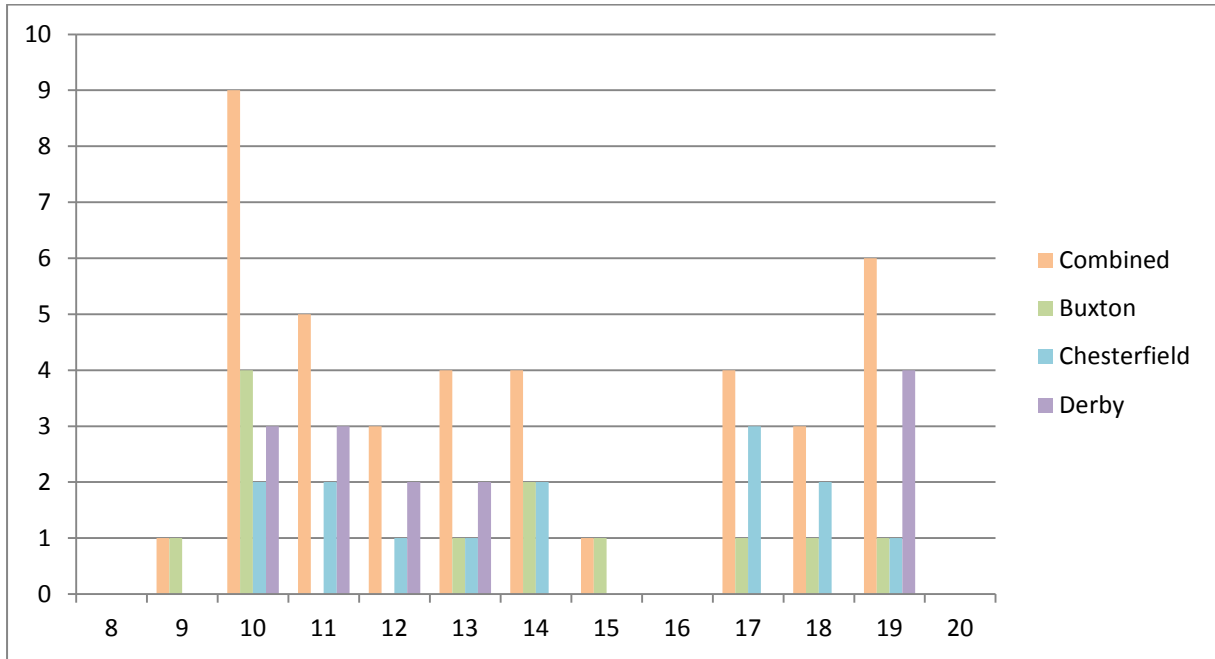
