

## Quarterly Report - July to September 2018

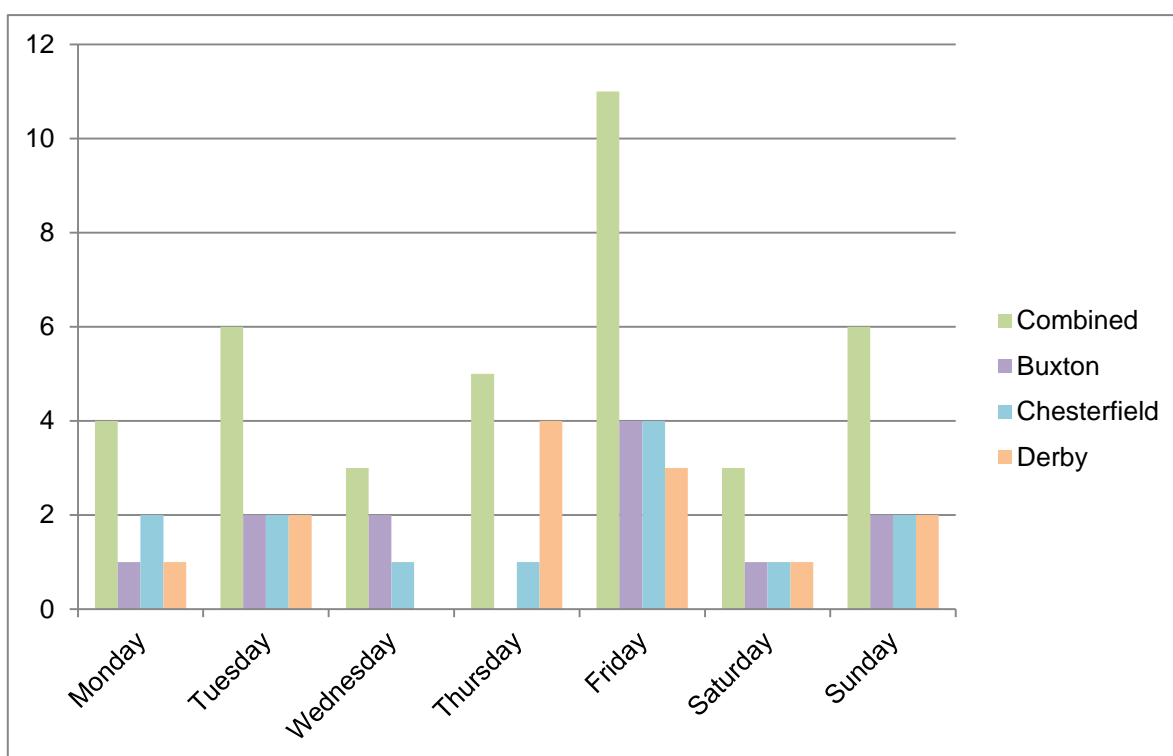
During the above period there were 3624 people held in custody in Derbyshire.

The below tables are statistics gathered from our Independent Custody Visiting Scheme.

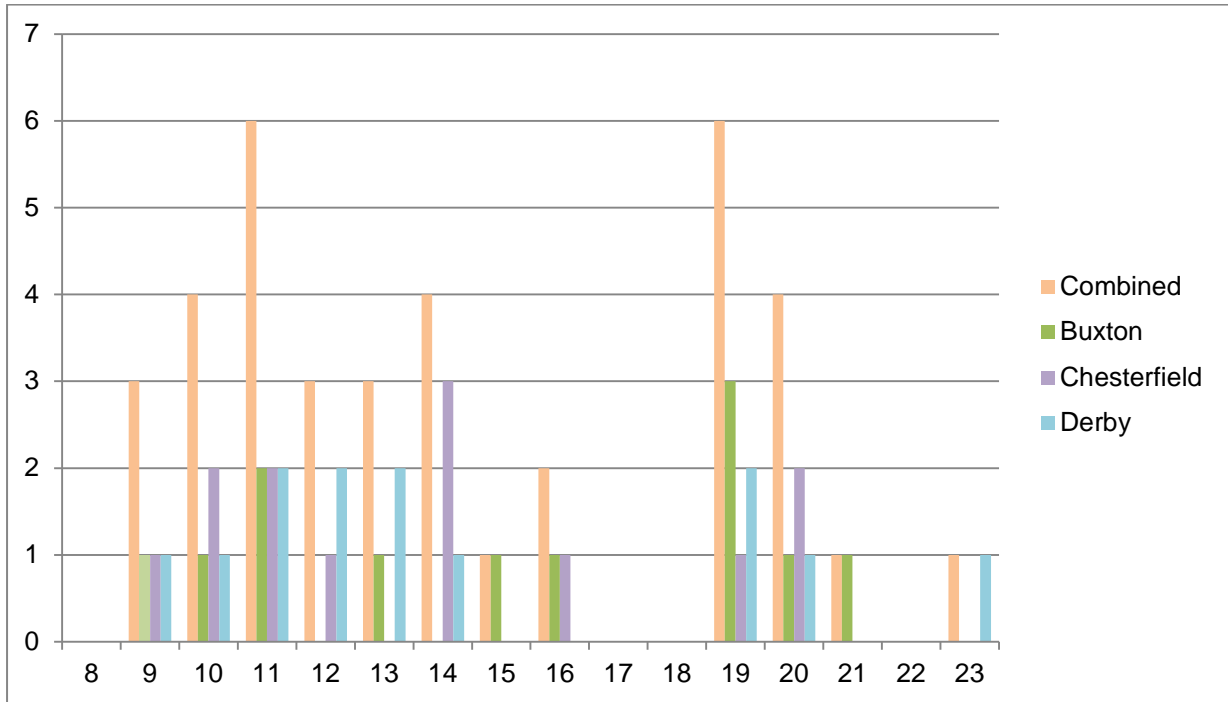
