During the above period there were 3533 people held in custody in Derbyshire.

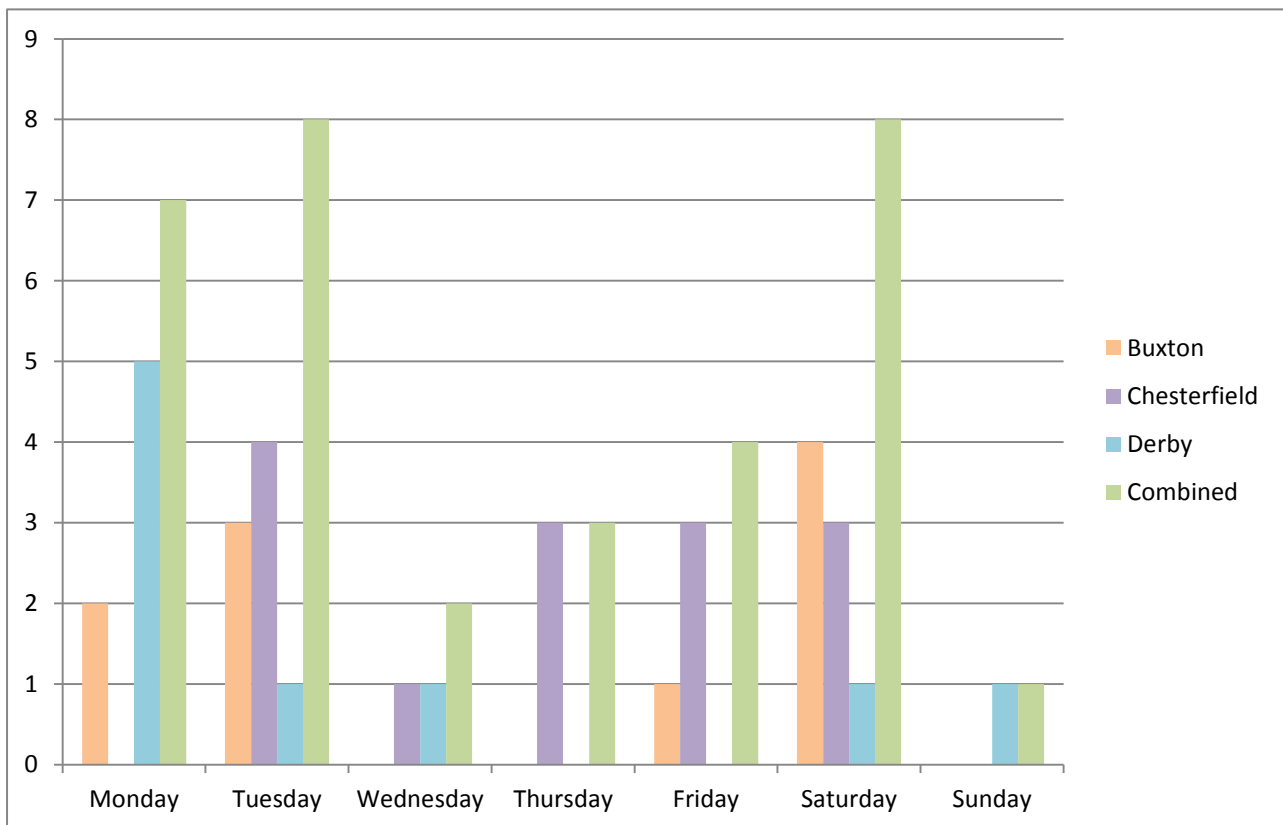

Number of Visits made by ICVs

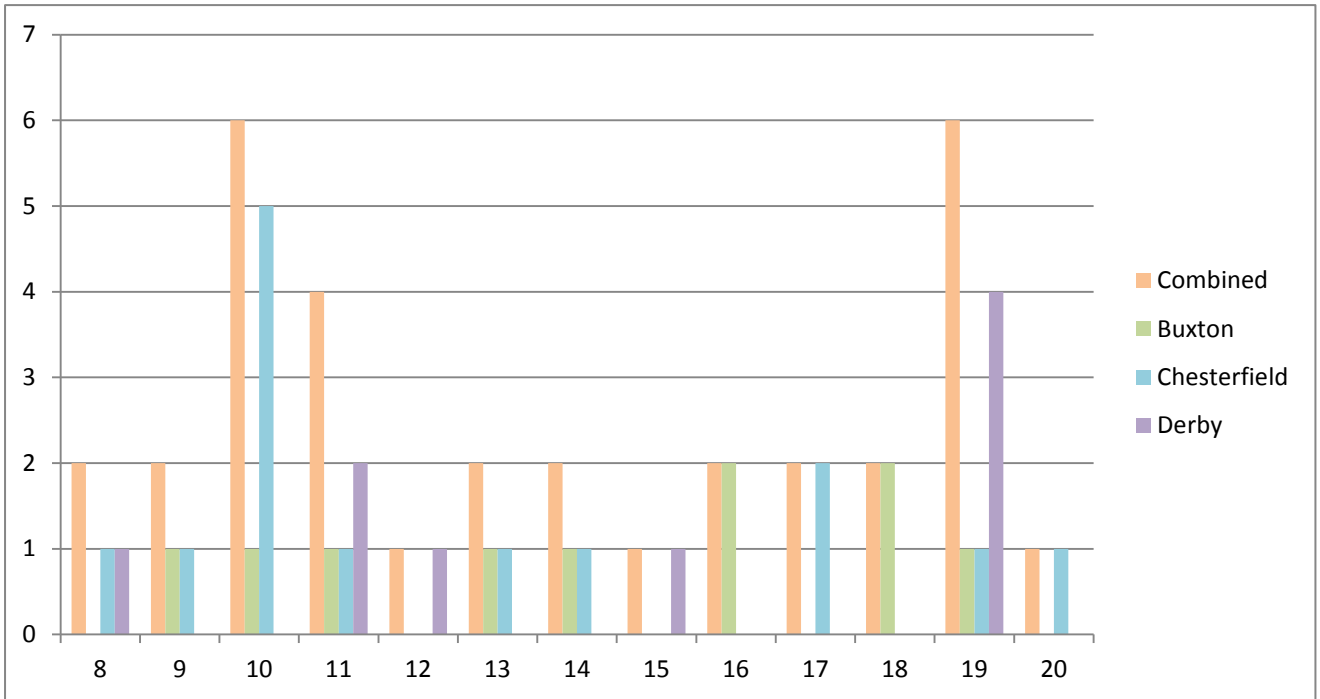
