NOTICE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS: AUDIT OF ACCOUNTS 2012/2013

Audit Commission Act 1998, sections 15 & 16 (the Act),

Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2011, regulations 9, 10, 21, 22 & 23 (the Regulations)

The Commissioner's accounts, the Chief Constable's accounts and the Group accounts (the accounts) are subject to external audit. Local government electors for the area have certain rights in the audit process.

Notice is hereby given that from **29 July 2013** to **23 August 2013** in office hours between 09.30 am to 4.30 pm any person may inspect and or make copies of the accounts for the above named bodies for the year ended 31 March 2013 and all supporting books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating thereto. Such documents will be available for inspection at the address where they are normally kept or otherwise by arrangement. Application should be made to Mr. D. Fern, Head of Strategic Finance, Derbyshire Constabulary, Constabulary HQ, Butterley Park, Ripley Derbyshire DE5 3RS (tel 0345 1233333).

Notice is given that from **27 August 2013** (between 09.30 am to 4.30 pm) until the conclusion of the audit process, a local government elector for the policing area, or his/her representative, may ask the auditor questions about the accounts. Please contact the engagement partner, Mr. John Cornett, KPMG LLP, 1 Waterloo Way, Leicester LE1 6LP to make arrangements to ask any questions.

From **27 August 2013** (between 09.30 am to 4.30 pm) until the conclusion of the audit process, under S16 of the Act, a local government elector for the policing area, or his/her representative, may object to the accounts asking that the auditor issue a report in the public interest (under section 8 of the Act) and/or apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law (under section 17 of the Act). Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the engagement partner at the address given above and copied to Mrs. H. Boffy, Treasurer, Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Derbyshire, Butterley Hall, Ripley Derbyshire DE5 3ES.
