I write in connection with your request for information sent to the Police and Crime Commissioner for Derbyshire on 10 August 2016 asking for information under the Freedom of Information Act. Please find below a note of your request and our response detailed in italics below:

Please advise what, if any transparency requirements you require of the police in your area or that you are planning to require. Please include any transparency requirements for the pay, expenses and allowances for the Chief Constable and other senior officers.

The Police and Crime Commissioner is required to publish certain pieces of information to ensure transparency. The principle document that outlines this is The Elected Local Policing Bodies (Specified Information) Order 2011 (as amended). When considering the pay, expenses and allowances for the Chief Constable and other senior officers, The Accounts and Audit (Amendment No 2) (England) Regulations 2009 came into force on 31 March 2010 and states that all senior staff and officers are required to disclose their salaries, fees, allowances, bonuses, expenses, redundancy payments, etc., and as such this information is published in the Group Accounts annually.
