Please provide full details of the income received by Derbyshire Constabulary from High Peak residents only via council tax.

There was a fall in income between 2012/13 and 2013/14, due to the introduction of Council Tax Benefit Grant (households in receipt of CT benefit were no longer included in the taxbase).

Please provide full details of the expenditure spent by Derbyshire Constabulary on front line Police services in the High Peak area only.

We are not able to provide details of what the costs of policing the High Peak area are due to the way in which modern policing is delivered. A great number of services are 'centralised' or run from remote response hubs and are by definition more mobile than the traditional style of policing. Derbyshire does not recharge central overheads (which include police officer salaries – the single biggest cost) to individual policing areas and so unfortunately can't provide the level of detail that you are asking for.

Further to your request for supplementary information sent to the Police and Crime Commissioner for Derbyshire on 31 May 2017.

Please find attached an overview of the physical number of officers and PCSOs in the High Peak from 2010 to 2016. I would however, highlight that providing a response to your specific request is limited view of policing service provided to residents of High Peak and indeed the whole of Derbyshire. Derbyshire Constabulary maintains effective policing services which comprises not only of local officers, but also covers the provision of specialist services which extend across the county, including the High Peak area.

The Constabulary is committed to providing an effective response to issues such as domestic abuse, child sexual exploitation, organised crime groups, protecting vulnerable people of all ages and the increasing demand placed on the police through online criminality. These issues all require specific investment and as such require significant resources.

Many of the issues faced by Derbyshire as outlined above may not be readily visible to local communities but the resources are available to meet demand in High Peak as they are any other community that we serve. The Constabulary works to efficiently tackle the most serious criminality and protect those who are vulnerable across the whole of the County.
