1 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

Recommend approval to award contract for the Provision of a Childrens Independent Sexual Violence Advisor (chisva) service to Derbyshire to SV2 Ltd, for the period of 1 April 2018 to 31 March 2021, with the option to extend for a further 2 x 12 months, for the total contract value of £189,110.

2 INFORMATION AND ANALYSIS

The delivery of Paediatric SARC services will change in Derbyshire from 1st April 2018 where NHSE are procuring an East Midlands regional service. As part of that same procurement process East Midlands Police and Crime Commissioners have agreed to co commission the Forensic Medical Examination with the SARC service to facilitate that integrated response for victims from a single centre and service.

To provide a local comprehensive seamless service Derbyshire partners have jointly determined the need for a local ChISVA service to be delivered alongside and integrated with the new Paediatric SARC provision from 1st April 2018.

The Commissioner is working in partnership with Derbyshire County and Derby City Councils, Derbyshire Constabulary and specialist providers. This includes Safeguarding Boards. Those parties will be members of a Victim Strategic Pathway Board, and will oversee the operation of the service, identify and support subsequent system wide changes and enable the PCC to oversee the performance of the contractor.

3 RECOMMENDATIONS

Confirm the recommendation to award the contract to SV2 Ltd for the period of 1 April 2018 to 31 March 2021, with the option to extend for a further 2 x 12 months, for the total contract value of £189,110.
