## OVERVIEW

Concerns have been raised as to the validity of previous electrical testing carried out, and whether the remedial works noted have been completed. This is an area of statutory compliance and needs addressing as a matter of urgency. The top 10 buildings have been identified by the Assets Team, and as such, these will be inspected and repaired as a matter of urgency.

## SUMMARY

Originally the exercise was thought to cost in the region £20,000 to £ 25,000 (to carry out 20% checking of the circuits per property) and so 3 quotes were sought, from contractors familiar with our sites. Further quotations were sought to seek quotations for 100% of the circuits.

A single Tender Waiver has been raised and signed off for this work to proceed.
