OVERVIEW The tender was run using an existing Efficiency East Midlands Framework, EE0024-2 OJEU Notice 2016/S 020-031462, using the Further Competition option. Using this Framework provides a compliant and swift route to market.

The Framework evaluation criteria was based on 60 % Quality and 40% Cost. The contract for this service, is to be awarded to the Most Economical Advantageous Tender, (MEAT) evaluating against the technical and general requirements, and costs.

3 Suppliers were invited and all 3 submitted tenders for review.

## SUMMARY

As the previous incumbent failed to deliver the services allocated, it is not possible to give an accurate figure for previous costs for this service. For the purposes of the evaluation, the hourly rates submitted, were applied to a scenario, which were then used to evaluate.

Quality is paramount in this service, and EAS Limited have provided excellent detailed answers, and have backed up their responses with case studies, and demonstrated their ability to support the Force through this program of work.

For these reasons EAS Limited scored maximum points for quality.
