1. OVERVIEW

Works required to upgrade Matlock station heating system and general internal upgrading to improve the station for users.

The evaluation team consisted of Joan Watson, Phil Munton & Andrew Kirkland

This was an open tender advertised on eu-supply.com and source derbyshire, using the most economical advantageous tender criteria (meat): weighting 40% price and 60% quality (delivery).

27 companies expressed an interest, 7 companies submitted bids, and all bids were evaluated. Based on the detailed evaluation, Midland Counties Heating Services Ltd scored highest on the combined quality and cost total figure. They demonstrated that they could meet the requirements which were outlined within the specification and provided a comprehensive response to the method statements.
