# **OVERVIEW**

The Police and Crime Commissioner for Derbyshire wishes to contract with a suitably qualified Contractor, a Controls specialist for the maintenance of the TREND Building Management System that is in use at several Derbyshire Constabulary sites. The requirement is for Planned Preventative Maintenance, reactive call outs and additional work schemes (small works).

The evaluation team consisted of Ray Poxon (Head of Procurement) and Phil Munton (Mechanical Engineer) for Derbyshire Constabulary.

This further competition was conducted under the EU Open Procedure. 23 suppliers submitted expressions of interest. 13 suppliers submitted a bid.

Based on the detailed evaluation, BMSI Limited received the highest points for their quality response. The evaluation panel were satisfied that the response from BMSI Limited could meet the requirements which were outlined within the specification.

BMSI also received the full 40.00 points as they were the most cost effective submission. The submission from BMSI Limited was within the original budget for this tender.
