#### **OVERVIEW**

The Police and Crime Commissioner for Derbyshire currently funds the City Independent Domestic Violence Advisor (IDVA) service and contributes to the joint commissioning of the County IDVA service.

It is the Police and Crime Commissioner's intention that from a victim's perspective the level, standard and experience of service is consistent regardless of where you live across Derbyshire and therefore whilst the specification relates to the provision of a City IDVA service, there are multiple references to aligned processes with the County IDVA service.

Both Derbyshire County Council and the PCC will require the successful provider to work "as a whole" with their counterpart service, protecting the victim journey and experience, so that the standard of service is consistent, and maximising efficiencies as far as is possible.

However, the PCC is the lead commissioner and will hold the contract with the successful provider of this City wide contract.

The contract is for the delivery of an IDVA service across the geographical area of Derby City.

The evaluation team consisted of Kevin Gillott (Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner), Dawn Robinson (Head of Commissioning, OPCC), Chief Inspector Claire Hammond (Operations Manager), Kirsty Holding (Procurement Assistant) and Rob Atkinson (Procurement Officer) for Derbyshire Constabulary.

This competition was conducted via an EU Open Procedure. 12 suppliers submitted expressions of interest. 2 suppliers submitted a bid

Based on the detailed evaluation Arch (North Staffs) Limited received the full 95.00 points for their quality response and the full 5.00 points for their price submission.

The submission from Arch (North Staffs) Limited was within the original budget set for this procurement.
