Overview

Currently there are 5 kitchens at St Marys Wharf that are in need of refurbishment and upgrading, the works will be carried out whilst the police station is fully operational.

The estimated costs for this project were £50k + VAT + Fees.

The evaluation team consisted of Joan Watson and Ian Tomblin.

This tender was run as a Further Competition, and advertised on EU-Supply and Source Derbyshire, using the Most Economical Advantageous Tender Criteria (MEAT): Weighting 50% Price and 50% Quality (delivery).

20 Companies expressed an interest, 7 Companies submitted bids, 2 bids were non-compliant and so 5 bids were evaluated.

Based on the detailed evaluation, J Tomlinson Limited scored highest on the combined quality and cost total figure. They demonstrated that they could meet the requirements which were outlined within the specification and provided a comprehensive response to the method statements.

Summary

The bids were assessed against the quality criteria set out in the invitation to tender document - most economical advantageous tender criteria (meat): weighting 50% quality (delivery) and 50% price the submission from J Tomlinsons Ltd is the successful bid.
