## 1. **OVERVIEW**

This was a further competition under the ESPO Framework 306\_16 advertised on EU-Supply.com using the Most Economical Advantageous Tender Criteria (MEAT): Weighting 40% Price and 60% Quality (delivery).

5 suppliers were invited to bid of which, 2 accepted the invitation and only 1 company, the incumbent supplier, PHS Compliance submitted a bid.

The evaluation team was Dan Linfield, Joan Watson and Jennifer Cawkwell.

PHS Compliance have proven themselves to be a good reliable competent contractor and we have an agreed pricing matrix that is valid for the duration of the contract of 3 years plus 1 year extension.

Due to the fluctuating number of appliances to be tested we don't have accurate data to cost

against. This also applies to the fixed wire element of this contract.
