Overview

Currently the tiered car park is cordoned off due to H & S risks and is need of repair so that the car park can be utilised again.

On the original notification of procurement the estimated cost for these works was £150,000 + vat and fees however, on further investigation it as noted that the existing electrical circuits had multiple repairs over the years and a decision was made to install brand new wiring to provide reliability.

The evaluation team consisted of Joan Watson, Jo Bingley, Jen Cawkwell & Ian Oldfield.

This was an open tender, and advertised on EU-Supply and Source Derbyshire, using the Most Economical Advantageous Tender Criteria (MEAT): Weighting 60% Price and 40% Quality (delivery).

6 Companies expressed an interest, 3 Companies submitted bids, so 3 bids were evaluated.

Based on the detailed evaluation, Alliance Contracting Solutions Ltd scored highest on the combined quality and cost total figure. They demonstrated that they could meet the requirements which were outlined within the specification and provided a comprehensive response to the method statements.
