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**RECOMMENDATION TO AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION OF A
TRAILER SOLUTION**

Executive Summary:

The East Midlands Region have received a delivery of 200 Live PRPS suits. The suits were delivered to Derbyshire as they have a bespoke storage facility and the plan is to disperse some to each of the 5 forces in the region to use for live incidents within their force areas but maintain a stock centrally for mobilisation to large scale events. The NCBRNC has made the region aware of financial support available from the centre in order for the region to implement a mobilisation solution for the PRPS suits.

Each of the suits comes in a box 810mm by 400mm by 345mm and weighs around 17kg. They come in sizes dependant on the wearers boot size so in order to equip officers on a live mobilisation a number of boxes will need to be taken to the scene. This therefore required each force having a transport option in order to take the boxes to the scene.

To award contract for the Provision and Maintenance of a Trailer Solution to be provided by Indespension Limited, for the period of 14 January 2019 to 13 January 2029, with no options to extend for the total contract value of £32,900.

OVERVIEW

The East Midlands Region have received a delivery of 200 Live PRPS suits. The suits were delivered to Derbyshire as they have a bespoke storage facility and the plan is to disperse some to each of the 5 forces in the region to use for live incidents within their force areas but maintain a stock centrally for mobilisation to large scale events. The NCBRNC has made the region aware of financial support available from the centre in order for the region to implement a mobilisation solution for the PRPS suits.

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The evaluation team consisted of Kirsty Holding (Procurement Assistant) and Police Constable Joshua Baker (Public Order Liaison Officer)

10 suppliers expressed an interest in this tender. 1 supplier submitted a response: Indespension Limited.

Based on the detailed evaluation, Indespension Limited received the highest possible marks for their response. They demonstrated that they could meet the requirements which were outlined within the specification and provided a comprehensive response to the method statements.

The bid was assessed against the quality criteria set out in the Invitation to Tender document - Most Economical Advantageous Tender criteria (MEAT): Weighting 20% Quality and 80% Price. The submission from Indespension Limited was within the original budget which was set for this procurement.
