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**VARIATION TO ENHANCED FINGERPRINT CAPTURE SOLUTION INC
SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE AND ASSOCIATED CSI EQUIPMENT (DN48)**

Executive Summary:

The contract relates to the purchase of new equipment and its' ongoing service and maintenance for a 5 year period. The contract value is £288,764.40 which was based on the cost of the new fingerprint capture equipment and it's ongoing support and maintenance. The deed of variation is required to amend the contract to include the service and maintenance of all other fingerprint capture equipment used by EMSOU-FS which amounts to an additional sum of £49,768.60 + vat over the 5 year period.

We have become aware that there is additional equipment in use by EMSOU-FS which is regularly serviced and maintained by foster and freeman limited for which there is no current contract in place. A variation to the contract for the enhanced fingerprint capture solution would not alter the overall nature of the existing contract which also includes associated CSI equipment and the value does not exceed 50% of the original contract value therefore under the public contracts regulations 2015 is permitted.

Decision

To approve the variation to the contract for the provision of Enhanced Fingerprint Capture Solution including Support and Maintenance and Associated CSI Equipment with Foster and Freeman Limited.
