Our current contract for the provision and maintenance of Structured Cabling is with Cable Dynamics which ends on 6 December 2019, with no further options to extend available. We therefore have a requirement to appoint a contractor to deliver the services required.

Cable Dynamics have been the incumbent supplier for a number of years for this provision.

This was an open tender advertised on EU-Supply.com and Source Derbyshire using the Most Economical Advantageous Tender Criteria (MEAT): weighting of 30% Price and 70% Quality (delivery).

RECOMMENDATIONS

The bids have been assessed against the quality criteria set out in the Invitation to Tender, using the Most Economical Advantageous Tender Criteria (MEAT): weighting of 30% Price and 70% Quality (delivery).

Using the above mentioned criteria the bids were evaluated and the submission from Cable Dynamics Limited, who are the incumbent supplier was the successful bid. The pricing was evaluated on the basis of a set list of potential cable requirements and service charges which don't provide a firm fixed contract

figure. As an indication of our average annual spend over the last 3 years has been £28000.

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OVERVIEW

Our current contract for the provision and maintenance of Structured Cabling is with Cable Dynamics which ends on 6 December 2019, with no further options to extend available. We therefore have a requirement to appoint a contractor to deliver the services required.

Cable Dynamics have been the incumbent supplier for a number of years for this provision.

This was an open tender advertised on EU-Supply.com and Source Derbyshire using the Most Economical Advantageous Tender Criteria (MEAT): weighting of 30% Price and 70% Quality (delivery). The contract was awarded to Cable Dynamics Ltd, who are the incumbent supplier.

24 companies expressed an interest, 4 bids were submitted of which 2 were non-compliant and therefore, 2 bids were evaluated.

The bids were evaluated by Joan Watson, Jennifer Cawkwell, Paul Grosse, Andrew, Hartshome, Phil Munton and Jo Bingley.

SUMMARY

It is our recommendation to award the contract for a 2 year period with the option to extend for a further 2 x 12 months to Cable Dynamics Limited.
