Executive Summary

The current agreement for the Provision of an Information Management System is due to expire on 4 May 2021.

A tender was conducted via the EU Open Procedure. 113 suppliers expressed an interest in the tender and 2 suppliers submitted a response. The tender was evaluated on the Most Economically Advantageous Tender (M.E.A.T) which was split between 80% quality and 20% price.

Geoff Smith Associates Limited were awarded 75.81 points for their quality submission, and 20 points for their price submission.

The submission from Geoff Smith Associates Limited was within the original budget for this tender.

The initial value of the contract is £261,800.00 and will commence on 4 January 2021. The contract will expire upon 5 years from Go Live, which is currently estimated to be 5 May 2021, with the option to extend for a further 12 months.
