HEALTH SCREENING AND FLU VACCINATIONS

Executive Summary

Health screening is offered to all Superintendents and flu vaccinations are offered force wide. On average 25/30 Superintendents take up the health screening and approx 900 flu vaccinations are provided.

As a result of the aggregated spend with each supplier we need to find a compliant route to purchase these services. The average annual spend on health screening is in the regional of £13k and on flu vaccinations £12/13k.

The NHS Shared Business Services Work Force Well Being Framework Agreement offers a compliant route to procure a variety of health screening programmes and vaccinations. Lot 1 of the framework has various providers who can offer health screening and vaccinations. It allows direct award and following evaluation of charges and service offering, People Asset Management have been chosen. Their prices offer savings in the region of 20% on the flu vaccinations and 8-10% on health screening checks against our current providers.

The contract term will be for two years with an estimated start date of 14th August 2020 with the option to extend for a further 24 months. The total value therefore, including the extension options is estimated to be in the region of £104,000.

Decision

To enter into contract with People Asset Management to provide health screening and vaccinations at a total estimated value, including extension options, in the region of £104,000.
