Executive Summary

Derbyshire Police have a contract for the Provision Vehicle Recovery Services. This is a specialist service that requires contractors to be able to recovery any type vehicle.

The original contract required a provider to manage our general recovery services such as cars, motorbikes and HGV lorries.

Within this original contract there wasn't a requirement for the recovery of plant & farm machinery, large scale vehicle parts seizure and miscellaneous recoveries and storage services. This contract variation now covers the more awkward vehicles noted and as such ensures Derbyshire Police are able to operate the fuller service that is required.

Recommend approval to vary the contract for the Provision of Vehicle Recovery Services to incorporate the recovery of plant & farm machinery, large scale vehicle parts seizure and miscellaneous recoveries and storage services.
