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**THE PROVISION, IMPLEMENTATION, TRAINING AND ON-GOING
SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF ANALYTICAL
INSTRUMENTATION FOR THE ANALYSIS OF ILLICIT DRUGS**

Executive Summary

This request relates to the variation of an existing contract with the supplier, Thermo Electron Manufacturing Ltd trading as Thermo Fisher Scientific. EMSOU- FS on behalf of the 5 East Midlands Forces, have a need to purchase an additional High Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC) instrument. The Lab has one machine at present which was purchased under contract reference DP0122 in 2017. In order to provide resilience an additional machine is required to ensure the service can continue to provide the high level of service to the regional forces in the identification of illicit drugs.

The contract awarded was for a 5 year period with the option to extend for 2 years and includes ongoing support and maintenance of the equipment. The contract period is: 1st Feb 2017 – 31st January 2022 (plus 2 x 12 month extension).

The value of the original contract is £97,232.26.

The supplier has provided a quotation for a further HPLC U3000 MWD machine at a cost of £48,000+ vat, including ongoing support and maintenance.

As the value is less than 50% of the original contract value a variation to the agreement is permitted under Regulation 72 of the Public Contract Regulations 2015.

Decision

To award a variation of an existing contract with the supplier, Thermo Electron Manufacturing Ltd trading as Thermo Fisher Scientific to purchase an additional High Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC) Instrument.

The contract awarded was for a 5 year period with the option to extend for 2 years and includes ongoing support and maintenance of the equipment. The contract period is: 1st Feb 2017 – 31st January 2022 (plus 2 x 12 month extension).
