Executive Summary

There are three ISDN30 lines in force, used for 999 calls. Two at Ripley Force HQ and one at St Mary's Wharf which is used for 999 resilience in the event of CMArc being evacuated. The St Mary's Wharf circuit is out of contract and therefore we intend to added this by moving the line to BT, who are our current ISDN line provider for the two circuits at Force HQ. The CCS framework RM3808 Network Services 2 has been identified as a compliant route to market which permits direct award to BT. The term of the contract is 2 years with a total contract value of £11,256 which includes all three circuits and critical care for the St Mary's Wharf circuit to match that of the existing BT circuits.
