In 2019 a contract was put in place for the provision of a service to support children and young people vulnerable to sexual and wider forms of exploitation (CSE). The service commenced on 13 January 2020 and is delivered by Catch 22 Charity Limited. Due to an increase in demand for the service a formal contract variation is required which will add an additional 1FTE post to the service which is already being delivered within Derbyshire. The £35,916.00 post is being funded by Derbyshire County Council of which will be detailed within the revised Partnership Agreement
