Supply and Fit of Tyres

The current contract for the supply and fit of vehicle tyres is via a Crown Commercial Services (CCS) Framework Agreement which ended on 10th October 2021.

CCS have established a new framework agreement for the supply and fit of vehicle tyres which includes a specific lot for Blue Light Emergency vehicles. Goodyear Dunlop (UK) Ltd, our incumbent provider, are the single supplier under the framework therefore direct award is permitted. The framework agreement is for a 4 year period with no extension options.

NB: The framework commenced on the 27th July 2021 however the documentation and details of the framework award were not made public until 28th September 2021

Goodyear Dunlop have been a supplier to the force for a number of years. They have always offered a competitive market price and proved to be a reliable and attentive supplier.

The award criteria used for the framework competition was based on the most economically advantageous tender (MEAT) and was defined in the contract notice as 60% quality and 40% price. As a result of the competitive tender process Goodyear were the successful bidder, in line with the published selection criteria.

Lot 1 was specified and evaluated by Police Fleet Managers to ensure it meets the needs of the Blue Light Sector.

Pricing under the new framework indicates an average 6% increase on the current contract price, which is accounted for by inflationary price increases since the last contract was awarded in 2016 and very specifically, cost increases in 2021 resulting from Brexit and Covid impacts. Additionally, tyre specifications have been changed by vehicle manufacturers on the new police fleet which we will also account for an increase in costs.

The estimated call-off contract value over 4 years is £742,000 with a

commencement date of 11th October 2021.
