Provision of Interactive Voice Solution

Derbyshire Constabulary (DC) provides a contact management function to the public via a staffed Control Room, accepting both emergency and non-emergency telephone contacts from callers dialling 999 or 101 within the region. Emergency contacts are handled by Control Management staff (agents) and prioritised over non-emergency contacts by default. Non-emergency contacts are automatically presented with a simple set of options that ultimately route them to either a staffed switchboard or to the agents. DC seek to implement a more flexible and fit-forpurpose IVR to improve non-emergency contact handling by more effectively intercepting and resolving contacts that do not require the attention of an agent. A route to market was identified via the Derbyshire IT Hardware, Software and Consumables framework which is in place with Insight Direct (UK) Limited and offers a compliant route to market via direct award. The business requirements were shared with appropriate suppliers who are partnered with Insight Direct (UK) Limited. A viable solution, offered by Netcall Technology Limited, has been evaluated by DC in accordance with a pre-agreed scoring criterion. Netcall Technology Limited's offering meets DC's requirements and therefore the contract for the Provision of an Interactive Voice Response (IVR) Solution is to be awarded to Insight Direct (UK) Limited (of which will be provided by Netcall Technology Limited) for the total contract value of £240,005.32 which covers the period of 5 years from go-live, which is currently estimated to be 1 August 2022.
