Centurion Licence and Support

The Professional Standards Department uses the Centurion Software Solution provided by the supplier, Force Information Systems Ltd, for their case management, recording and process control. The software is a police specific product used by 96% of police forces. The Force has renewed the license agreement on a rolling annual basis however due to the value of this spend we need to find a compliant route to procure the licences. The department has reviewed the market and confirmed that there currently isn't any alternative solution available. The current agreement is for 49 licences having added an additional 5 licences in October 2021 for use by the OPCC. The renewal date is 31st March 2022. A compliant route has been identified via the Health Trust Europe ICT Solutions 2019 Framework Agreement using the value added re-seller, Specialist Computer Centres PLC (SCC). The framework permits direct award, and it is our intention to award a contract to SCC for 3 years with a 12 month extension option. The initial contract period will be 1st April 2022 to 31st March 2025. SCC have provided a quotation for the initial 3 year term in the total sum of £79,098.80 + vat.
