Wi-Fi Surveys

There is a requirement to provide a Wi-Fi first network provision across Derbyshire Constabulary, driven by a Network Strategy (May 2021) with the outcome of a 'Next Generation Network' that will facilitate connectivity in line with technical growth for Derbyshire Constabulary over the next 5 years.

White Star specialise in Wi-Fi surveys and access point installations, with current high demand on internal network resources, this option has been decided by IS as the most suitable option to complete the site surveys and access point installations to facilitate this project as a timely solution. The outcome being that all sites will be surveyed, the most efficient locations for access points identified to allow internal Network engineers to create heat spot maps.

A route to market has been identified via the NHS Shared Business Services Digital Workplace Solutions Framework and offers a compliant route to market via direct award.

The total value of the contract is £19,088.70, and this is to cover the full term of the contract.
