FOI Request: 35/2023

I write in connection with your request for information received in the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Derbyshire on the 21st November 2023. You asked the following questions:

"A) Do you have any policies regarding masturbation by serving police officers, whilst on duty or masturbarting to evidence whilst off-duty?

I have information that the police are routinely masturbating to people's abuse videos recovered during investigations

B) I have also information that the police can recover abuse memories through Liquid Crystal Displays (LCDs) and Custom Operating Systems (OSes) if enough points of lights or photons have been suicided into them. Please confirm or deny if this is the case.

C) I have also information from the destroyers dimension (transverse waves) that they are remotely programming individuals using leafpad (double-sided A1/A2 touchscreen) technologies - harnessing the power of Satan (a dimension 90 degrees to reality) to remotely view an individual's life.

If you are not satisfied with our response to your request, under Section 17 of the FOIA of the FOIA you are entitled to ask for an internal review of our decision. Any internal review needs to be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of this response and state why you are unhappy with the response. You can submit an internal review in the following ways:

If you are not satisfied with the outcome of the internal review under Section 50 of the FOIA you can apply directly to the Information Commissioner (ICO) for a decision.
