Mobile Crime Scene App

EMSOU-FS use a Mobile Crime Scene Application to allow agile working for Crime Scene Investigators. They currently use iExamine and there is an ongoing requirement for support and maintenance of this application

The benefits of this is that it improves the timeliness of scene examinations, provides full auditing and continuity, reduces administration of scene tasking and improves the mobility of CSI's.

There is a further requirement to work with the supplier to update the current software that we use to meet Forensic Science Regulator quality standards

This Contract will be in place for 3 years from 22 November 2025 until 21 November 2028. There is then the option to extend the Contract for a further 12 months until the 21 November 2029

A compliant route to market has been identified via a Direct Award against the G-Cloud 14 Framework Agreement (RM1557.14). This allows for direct award to Injenuity for this requirement. The total value of the contract awarded to Injenuity is £41,200. This covers the initial terms and the period of 3 years from 22 November 2025 to 21 November 2026


