Auto-redaction is a tool that utilises artificial intelligence (AI) to scan documents for personally identifiable information (PII). The tool highlights the identified PII for the user, allowing for quick and accurate redaction. This process significantly speeds up the redaction task and improves its accuracy by reducing human error. Once the redaction is complete, the tool produces a redacted PDF version of the document, ensuring that sensitive information is securely remove.

The total value of the contract is £193,050 which covers the period of 36 months from 20/04/2026 to 19/04/2029 with 1 x 12 month extension.


