A compliant route to market has been established via CCS RM6259, Lot 3 which allows for Direct Award to Causeway for 3 years. Causeway's standard annual increase will be applied at each annual renewal; at the time of issuing this is 7.5%. The total value of the contract is £4,043 per annum which covers the period of 36 months from 16/04/2026 to 15/04/2029.


