Insurance Decision Notice

All current insurance policies held by The Police and Crime Commissioner for Derbyshire and The Chief Constable of Derbyshire Constabulary are due to expire on 31 March 2026. Therefore, a competitive tender process has been undertaken for the renewal of our cover across separate lots.

Lot 1 relates specifically to Property Damage (General & Commercial), Business Interruption (Increased Cost Of Working, Gross Revenue, Rent), Computers and Contract Works.

The contract has been awarded for an initial term of three years, with the option for the customer to extend for a further two 12-month periods. The contract start date is 1 April 2026, and the final end date, including extension options, is 31 March 2031.

The total contract value per annum for this lot is £60,346.83. This includes our Insurance Premium and a standard 12% Insurance Premium Tax.

The procurement process was undertaken in accordance with the Public Contracts Regulations 2015, utilising the YPO Dynamic Purchasing System (DPS) for Insurance Placement.

Contracts have

been awarded on the basis of the most economically advantageous tender, with evaluation undertaken using a weighting of 60% for quality and 40% for price.

For this lot, we had six bidders. Protector were the winning bidders, achieving a

40% price score and 51% quality score. They have therefore been successful and they are the winning bidder for Lot 1 of our Insurance Placement – Property.


