Zip Water Taps

A contract is required for the servicing and maintenance of the Zip Water taps already installed across the sites.

This is a 48-month plan with 6 monthly services for 64 HydroTaps and 22 HydroBoils.

A compliant route to market has been found to call-off against the NHS SBS Hard Facilities Management 2 (SBS10166) Framework agreement as a direct award with Zip Water.

The total value of the contract is £154,272, which covers the period of 36 months from 1st February 2024 to 31st January 2027, with the option to extend for a further 12 months.
