The Police and Crime Commissioner for Derbyshire wanted to establish a Service for all Young Victims of Crime who are under the age of 18 years in Derbyshire (to include Derby City). The service will complement the commissioned service for Adults and other Specialist Provision. The Provider will deliver an evidence-based, trauma-informed and Restorative Support Service within Derbyshire that meets the needs of young victims and that can demonstrate co-operation with a range of organisations and partners in the city and county including the other services forming the PCC's CoRe victims offer. This will include a range of statutory agencies such as the Councils, the Police and Health Organisations and a range of other support services. 18 suppliers expressed their interest in the tender and one bid was received from Remedi (Restorative Services). Remedi are the incumbent provider and following on from an open tender process they are the winning bidder. This Provision is jointly funded by the PCC and the Supplier using a partnership agreement. The PCC will contribute £300,000 and Remedi will contribute £268,300.00. Therefore, the total value of the contract is £568,300 which covers the period of 36 months from 03/01/2023 to 31/03/2026, and the option to extend for a further 24 months.
