Provision of Self Service Lockers for IT Equipment

The IS Department at Derbyshire Constabulary have been looking to improve the service provision to officers for the delivery of IT equipment. Their strategic aim is to achieve a significant reduction in lost time for operational officers travelling to FHQ from both North and South division, and to have central collection points. The Self-Service Lockers will potentially be located at Force HQ, Chesterfield HQ and St Mary's Wharf HQ. The benefit to these lockers will mean a reduction in force travelling times, a reduction in time spent by officers and staff attending FHQ helpdesk, and a reduction in IS staff time handling equipment.

Approval has been granted for these lockers through a recent business case.

A route to market has been identified via the Derbyshire IT Hardware, Software and Consumables Framework which is in place with Insight Direct (UK) Limited, as it offers a compliant route to market via direct award.

The cost includes all hardware and 12 months warranty, support and maintenance. Support and maintenance will be put in place for after the initial warranty ends.

The call off contract for the Self-Service Lockers is to be awarded to Insight Direct (UK) Limited for the total value of £43,857.60. Supporting
