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**DP0568 NETW ZERO AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY**

**Executive Summary**

The Force in collaboration with the Fire Service and DPFP LLP, wishes to commission an external consultant to develop a bespoke strategy and action plan for each organisation to progress the ambition towards net zero carbon development by 2050 in response to the Climate Change Act and the targets as set by the Local Authorities, the Police and Crime Commissioner and Derbyshire County Council.

In accordance with the Public Contract Regulations 2015 (the "Regulations"), an open tender was issued on the Supply portal of which nine bids were received.

The bids have been assessed against quality criteria set out in the Invitation to tender document and the most advantageous tender criteria (MEAT) with weightings 45% quality, 45% price and 10% presence of a local business.

Essentia Trading Limited (ETL) achieved the highest score overall and are therefore the successful bidder.

The contract will commence as soon as possible, likely to be 1st August 2021, and will continue until the project is complete, with a proposed timeline of 26 weeks.

The value of the contract is £39,497.00 + vat.
